# The United States of America.

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

**Whereas** *Sacot S Van Valkenburg, of La Porte, Indiana,*  
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *La Porte,*  
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Sacot S Van Valkenburg,*  
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for  
the North East quarter of the North West quarter of section twenty seven, in Township  
thirty seven, South, of Range five, West of the second Meridian, in the District of lands  
subject to sale at *La Porte, Indiana,* containing forty acres  
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-  
chased by the said *Sacot S Van Valkenburg*

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the  
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Sacot*  
*Van Valkenburg* and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described:  
To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said  
*Sacot Van Valkenburg* and *to his* heirs and assigns forever.
