To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas *Veri Dames Sons* of *La Porte County Indiana* has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *La Porte*, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Veri Dames Sons* according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for *the West half of the South West quarter of Section nineteen, in Township thirty five, North, of Range five, East of the second Meridian, in the District of lands Subject to Sale at La Porte, Indiana containing eighty one acres and ninety three hundredths of an acre* according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Veri Dames Sons*

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Veri Dames Sons* and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Veri Dames Sons* and *his* heirs and assigns forever.
