Isaac Cornell assignee of) **To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:**

Whereas *Bela Smith Cornell of La Porte County, Indiana* has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at La Porte whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Bela Smith Cornell* according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 21st of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South East quarter of Section thirty five, in Township thirty seven North, of Range six West, in the District of lands subject to sale at La Porte, Indiana, containing one hundred and sixty ^{acres} according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Bela Smith Cornell*

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Bela Smith Cornell Isaac Cornell* and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described. To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said *Bela Smith Cornell Isaac Cornell* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
