To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Enos Thomas Apsinee, of William Nicholas Switzer of Laporte County, Indiana,
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Laporte,
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Nicholas Switzer
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 25th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for
the West half of the North East quarter, of Section twelve, in Township thirty six North of range
six West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Laporte Indiana containing Eighty Acres.
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said William Nicholas Switzer.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Enos Thomas,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described:

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said
Enos Thomas and to his heirs and assigns forever.
