the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Eight, and the West half and North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section Nine in Township Thirty five North of Range Six West in the District of Lands - subject to sale at La Porte Indiana containing in all One hundred and sixty acres -

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tracts have been purchased by the said *William Walker*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said *William Walker*

and to *his* heirs, the said tracts above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *William*

Walker

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
