Anthony Torbet and George Olinger according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the North West quarter of Section Twenty Three in Township Thirty six North of Range Six West in the District of Lands subject to sale at La Porte Indiana containing Eighty acres -

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said Anthony Torbet and George -

Olinger - **NOW KNOW YE**, That the **United States of America**, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said Anthony Torbet and George Olinger

and to their heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Anthony

Torbet and George Olinger and to their heirs and assigns forever. As Tenants in common and not as joint Tenants -
