the North half of the North West quarter of Section six, in Township thirty three, North, of Range six West, ^{of the same principal meridian} in the District of Lands subject to sale at Winamac, Indiana, containing eighty two Acres and eighty seven hundredths of an Acre.

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Daniel Dye

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
