Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the South East quarter of Section Fourteen in Township Thirty three North of Range Five West of the Second principal meridian, in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at *Winnamac, Indiana,* containing Eighty acres.

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *John Perrier*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *John Perrier*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
