To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. *6916* for *160* acres, issued in favor of *Nancy Kennedy, Widow, of John Kennedy deceased, Private, Captain M. Cormick's Company United States Rangers* *Wm of 1812*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *South East quarter of section two, in Township thirty, three, of Range five west, in the District of Kansas Sub ject to sale at Winamac Indeance containing one hundred and sixty acres*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: *Which has been assigned to Mark G Rees and James Pullan*

Now know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Mark G Rees and James Pullan*

the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Mark G Rees and James Pullan and to their*

heirs and assigns forever.
