Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 35,906 for 80 acres, issued in favor of Benjamin Sandbury Private in Captain Loraner's Company Virginia Militia Mar 1812 Two Services

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the East half of the South West quarter of Section Ten in Township Thirty four of Range Five West in the District of Lands subject to sale at Winamac Indiana containing Eighty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: Which has been assigned to Mark Ewan Reeves

Now Know Ye That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Mark Ewan Reeves

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Mark Ewan Reeves and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
