KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

Edward Severall, Private United States Marines,

having deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** a **WARRANT** in *his* favor numbered *65,966*

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *Ezekiel Morrison, assignee* of said *Edward Severall*, and *his heirs*, the *East half of the North East quarter and the East half of the South East quarter of Section Seven, in Township Thirty six North, of Range Seven West, in the District of lands subject to Sale at Winumau, Indiana, containing One hundred and thirty two acres and twenty three hundredths of an acre*

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tracts ~~have~~ been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said *parts of said* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

Ezekiel Morrison, and his

heirs and assigns forever.
